On 03/06/2022 at approximately 2130 hours Montgomery County Police (MCP) officers were dispatched to 5601 Lambeth Road, Bethesda, Montgomery County, Maryland for the report of a stabbing. The 911 caller stated that her son had just stabbed her husband.

On arrival MCP officers encountered an adult male subject in the front yard who stated that he had stabbed his father. This subject was later identified as twenty-year-old Sergio Koyangbo ("the Defendant").

As officers made their way into the residence, they found a knife on the stairs leading up to the front door.

Inside the residence officers then found an adult male suffering from what appeared to be a stab wound. The subject was transported to Suburban Hospital where he ultimately succumbed to his injuries and his death was pronounced. The deceased male was identified as forty-six-year-old David Beasley ("the Victim").

MCP investigators subsequently interviewed the Victim's wife and minor children who were present in the residence when the Victim was stabbed.

The wife disclosed that moments before she called 911, she and the Victim were in their bedroom when the Defendant entered the room. The Defendant confronted the Victim and began accusing him of going through the Defendant's internet search history. The Defendant then pulled a knife from his sweatshirt pocket and stabbed the Victim in the chest unprovoked. One of the minor children reported opening a door to the room and seeing the Defendant standing over the Victim and the Defendant had a knife in his right hand.

Based upon the foregoing, your Affiant has probable cause to believe that Sergio Koyangbo stabbed and killed David Beasley.

All of the above events supporting the requested charges listed below occurred in Montgomery County, Maryland.

Your Affiant believes there is probable cause to issue an arrest warrant charging the Defendant, Sergio

NOTICE OF ADVICE OF RIGHT TO COUNSEL FOR ALL JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS

TO THE PERSON CHARGED:

1. This paper charges you with committing a crime.
2. If you have been arrested and remain in custody, you have the right to have a judicial officer decide whether you should be released from jail until your trial.
3. If you have been served with a citation or summons directing you to appear before a judicial officer for a preliminary inquiry at a date and time designated or within five days of service if no time is designated, a judicial officer will advise you of your rights, the charges against you, and penalties. The preliminary inquiry will be cancelled if a lawyer has entered an appearance to represent you.
4. You have the right to have a lawyer.
5. A lawyer can be helpful to you by:
 - (A) explaining the charges in this paper;
 - (B) telling you the possible penalties;
 - (C) explaining any potential collateral consequences of a conviction, including immigration consequences;
 - (D) helping you at trial;
 - (E) helping you protect your constitutional rights; and
 - (F) helping you to get a fair penalty if convicted.
6. Even if you plan to plead guilty, a lawyer can be helpful.
7. If you are eligible, the Public Defender or a court-appointed attorney will represent you at any initial appearance before a judicial officer and at any proceeding under Rule 4-216.2 to review an order of a District Court commissioner regarding pretrial release. If you want a lawyer for any further proceeding, including trial, but do not have the money to hire one, the Public Defender may provide a lawyer for you. To apply for Public Defender representation, contact a District Court commissioner.
8. If you want a lawyer but you cannot get one and the Public Defender will not provide one for you, contact the court clerk as soon as possible.
9. **DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE DATE OF YOUR TRIAL TO GET A LAWYER.** If you do not have a lawyer before the trial date, you may have to go to trial without one.

NOTICE TO DEFENDANT

1. **MUST APPEAR** - If the offense with which you are charged is a 'MUST APPEAR' offense, you may not waive trial but are required to appear in court when notified. PLEASE NOTE THAT FAILURE TO APPEAR MAY RESULT IN A WARRANT FOR YOUR ARREST.
2. **PRESET FINE** - You must either pay the preset fine, request a waiver hearing, or request a trial date within 30 days after receipt of the citation/summons/warrant.

4. If you are unemployed:
Proof of public assistance, medical assistance, Social Security or Supplemental Security Income (SSI), or other assistance you are receiving.
