Charges Issued for Oakdale High School Bomb Threat *Charges Include Threat of Mass Violence*

FREDERICK, Md. (Aug. 18, 2022) – At approximately 7:28 a.m. today, a Frederick County Sheriff's Office (FCSO) School Resource Officer (SRO) at Oakdale High School received notification of a threat of violence made to the Oakdale High School community. Throughout the building cell phone users received several images with text that alluded to a bomb threat imposed over the images, via Apple's AirDrop feature.

FCSO SRO's and detectives immediately started an investigation into the threats. The school was in "hold" status while the deputies and school administrators investigated and ultimately determined the threat was not credible. A "hold" status means all students and staff remain in place until released by school or law enforcement authorities.

Throughout the course of the day SROs conducted multiple interviews and successfully identified a suspect, a male juvenile who is a student at the school. Deputies charged the suspect, via a juvenile referral, with Threats of Mass Violence and Disruption of School Activities.

Since the suspect is a juvenile, the FCSO will not release the name and any other identifying information. Additionally, Frederick County Public Schools may enact their own disciplinary actions.

"This behavior is never acceptable, it doesn't matter if it is the first or last day of school," said Sgt. Kevin Britt, FCSO SRO sergeant. "The Frederick County Sheriff's Office will not tolerate these threats of mass violence in or directed at our schools and children. We will continue to treat every threat seriously and criminally charge those responsible when appropriate."
