## MPD Investigating a Fatal Shooting in Northwest D.C.

WASHINGTON, D.C. – Detectives from the Metropolitan Police Department's Homicide Branch are investigating a fatal shooting in Northwest, D.C.

On Sunday, March 17, 2024, at approximately 3:01 a.m., Third District officers responded to the intersection of 7<sup>th</sup> and P Streets, Northwest, for the report of a shooting. When they arrived, they located three men and two women in the 600 block of P Street, Northwest, all suffering from gunshot wounds. All five victims were transported to local hospitals for treatment of their injuries. Two additional men were located with gunshot wounds. They both died at the scene.

The motive for this shooting remains under investigation. The preliminary detectives' investigation suggests that one or more suspects intentionally discharged a firearm at the victims.

The victims have been identified as **32-year-old Anthony Brown** of Southeast, DC and **32-year-old Jay Lucks** of Baltimore, MD

The Metropolitan Police Department currently offers a reward of up to \$25,000 per victim, bringing the total possible reward up to \$50,000 to anyone who provides information that leads to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for this offense.
