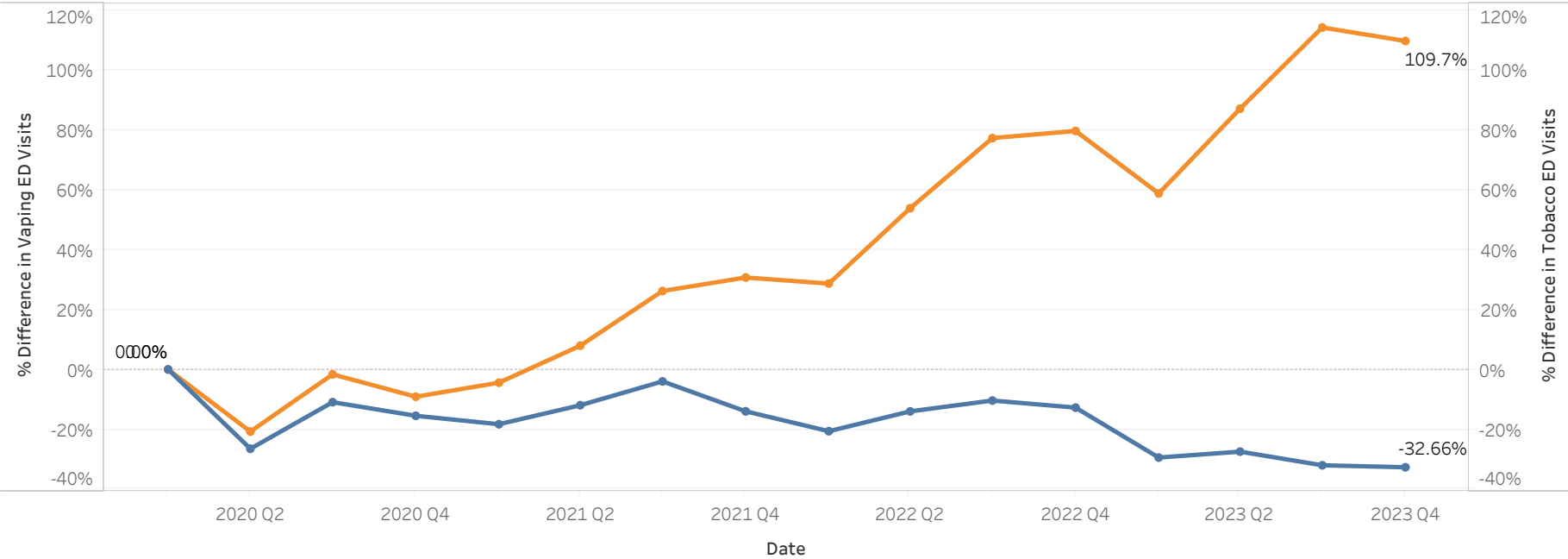


# Virginia Emergency Department Visits with a Tobacco and/or Vaping Diagnoses

**Data Source:** VHHA Outpatient & Inpatient Databases. The total number of Emergency Department (ED) visits with a tobacco and/or vaping diagnosis (ICD-10 code) includes all ED visits and ED visits that resulted in inpatient admissions. This data is sourced from the Virginia Hospital & Healthcare Association (VHHA) Inpatient and Outpatient databases. The analysis criteria used to pull this data include definitions from reputable sources. Specifically, tobacco use disorder is defined according to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) Chronic Conditions Warehouse (CCW) Tobacco Use Disorder (<https://www2.ccwdata.org/documents/10280/19140001/oth-cond-algo-tobacco.pdf>) Criteria, and vaping diagnosis codes are defined by the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) Vaping Diagnosis Codes ([https://downloads.aap.org/AAP/PDF/2G\\_Coding\\_and\\_Billing\\_for\\_E-cigarettes.pdf](https://downloads.aap.org/AAP/PDF/2G_Coding_and_Billing_for_E-cigarettes.pdf)). This data reflects ED visits from all private hospitals and health systems across Virginia.
